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3. School Location area is subject to building furniture staffing and financial benefits etc., the educational institution may in no case open more sections: without prior permission from the government.
4. The school shall be open only in the sanctioned medium and in the same place and shall not be allowed to be transferred for any reason.
5. This institute shall comply with all government orders and regulations issued by and in connection with the education of the Karnataka 1983[Karnataka Act No 1:96] and the rules laid down there under do not miss.
6. According to this high school registration government notification No: ED:175:PMC:95, dated 07/09/1998 and dated 29/12/1998 will be permanently unaided not wanting to give a certified consent letter in front of the Notary on the Rs 10/- stamp paper.
7. Karnataka private educational institutions employees Recruitment service terms and conditions of privately funded primary and secondary education rules 1999 should be followed compulsorily.
8. The department and the government mandated textbook should only adopt test procedures.
9. Each attendance class must have a minimum attendance of 25.
10. Only trained and qualified teachers shall be appointed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the department. Accreditation and provisional accreditation of all schools registered under subsection 36-39 under Article 8 of the Karnataka Education bill.
11. Medical examination of students should be regulated every year.
12. In order to start the school, the institution should keep the security deposit in the joint account of the District Deputy Director and the governing council.
13. The Karnataka Education bill stipulates that the school will be provided that the school will be provided with furniture, books, play grounds, school buildings and other facilities within a year. If not, registration will be cancelled.
14. The school must notify the office of the school's openness and student enrolment information within three months of the school's enrolment or the

start of the academic year, if the school does not open and no conditions are met, this order is automatically cancelled.

15. A separate toilet system for girls and boys in the school must be provided and a clean drinking water system.

16. Submission of the first accreditation within three months of commencement on the basis of the supplemental third checklist information of the Deputy Director of Education Act and government order dated 30.09.2017. Registration is automatically cancelled if it is not recognized within the stipulated period.

17. Ensure that school buildings safety is safe from fire, storm surge accidents. The announcement on the school front that the sale of tobacco products is prohibited within 100 yards of the school premises.

18. The department reserves the right to cancel registration if the school premises.

With reference to your application dated 28/03/2025 and subsequent school inspection in this regard, I hereby convey the grant of Recognition to The Secretary/Principal VIGNAAN e-TECHNO ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL-CBSE, NEAR SIDDIPRIYA KALYANA MANTAPPA, HOSPET TQ VIJAYANAGARA DIST-583201 for class I to X standard for the period 10 years from the academic year 2024-25 TO 2033-34, in compliance to section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education, Act, 2009 & sub- rule 4 of Rule 12 of The Karnataka State Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2010.

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions: -

1. The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid from the academic year 2024-25 and is to be renewed at an interval of every year.
2. The grant of recognition is available initially for classes I to VIII standard and to be extended for Secondary /Senior Secondary classes subsequently in due course of time.
3. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the RTE Rule 2010 of Karnataka State Education Act 2009.
4. The school shall admit in pre-school / class I to the extent of 25 of the strength in each class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
5. The school shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of reimbursement.

6. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
7. The school shall not deny admission to any child, -
 - a. For lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
 - b. On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
8. The school shall ensure that, -
 - a. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - b. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - c. No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - d. Inclusion of students with disabilities/ special need as per provision of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the RTE Rule 2010 of Karnataka State Education Act 2009. (rule/ clause of State Act).
 - e. The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the RTE Rule 2010 of Karnataka State Education Act 2009. (rule/ clause of the state Act).
 - f. The teachers perform his duties specified under Section 24(1) of Act and Rule 17 of RTE ..
9. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
10. The school shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the RTE Rule 2010 of Karnataka State Education Act 2009. (rule/ clause of the state Act) (rule/ clause of the state Act).
11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
12. The school building plan must have been approved by the current rules or G. Os. The school building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not be carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respect are under whole responsibility of the managements.
13. The school is run by Trust/a society registered under the Mysore Societies Registration Act NoIII of 1904.
14. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared.
16. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

17. KANNADA (language subject) shall be taught as a subject from in standards I to X in all schools notified under Karanataka Education ACT (concerned Act/ rule) from academic session recognition is granted.
18. The school shall abideby the provisions of the Govt of Karnataka State Act/ Rules.
19. The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfilment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any stage/ time.
20. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities.
21. The management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to this Office of - The Deputy Director for Public Instruction, VIJAYANAGARA
22. The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/ Department from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the school.
23. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rule or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.
24. The school management shall have to full responsibility if any court cases arises this regard. The management is not entitled to seek affiliation to other Board without obtaining NOC from the Concerned Authority -Department of Education Govt of Karnataka.
